### **FRANKLIN EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION**

**Award:** \$1,500

**Eligibility:** is limited to graduating Franklin High School seniors who plan to pursue post-secondary education in a healthcare or health-related field.

#### **Scholarship Overview**

The Healthcare Pathways Scholarship recognizes a graduating senior from Franklin High School who plans to pursue post-secondary education in a healthcare or health-related field. This scholarship honors students who have demonstrated compassion, responsibility, and interest in improving the health and well-being of others.

Eligible applicants intend to pursue a degree or certification leading to a career in healthcare, including fields such as nursing, medicine, allied health, public health, therapy, or healthcare support professions. Students may demonstrate interest through coursework, healthcare-related employment, volunteer service, job shadowing, internships, or participation in health sciences programs.

The \$1,500 award is intended to support post-secondary education expenses and encourage continued progress toward a healthcare career that serves individuals and communities.

#### **Application Requirements**

Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application, a current résumé outlining employment, extracurricular activities, volunteer involvement, and leadership experiences, an official or unofficial high school transcript, and at least one letter of evaluation from a teacher, counselor, mentor, volunteer supervisor, or employer (letters from family members will not be accepted).
